## YOUR HELP IS NEEDED!

**Emmanuel is growing!** In order to keep up with this incredible growth, we need YOU to help in these areas! Please pray for God's wisdom, guidance and willingness. THANK YOU!

**NURSERY:** Help approximately once every 2 months from beginning of Sunday morning worship until completion.

**W.O.W.** (Walk-Out-Worship): Share a Bible story or be a helper approximately once every 6 weeks to children ages 3-8 during the last part of the Sunday morning worship.

**SOUND SYSTEM:** Arrive an hour before Sunday worship to work the sound board for microphones, keyboard and guitar. There is an easy to follow check list available. Training is offered.

**VIDEO:** Arrive an hour before Sunday worship to go over worship slides with the leader. Click slides and play videos during service. Training is available.

**USHERS:** Arrive 30 minutes prior to the worship service to seat people.

**LIBRARY:** Arrive 20-30 minutes prior to the worship service and help with checking books and videos in and out.
